Style Notes: 1. "First Items" includes any item whereby a new case style, case finish, model type or variation, mechanical improvement or other attribute is either a first instance or there is some indication that it has changed.

2. Column "M" shows the Style Mark placed in the appropriate ledger page style column. Normally it is a simple, nearly vertical line ("|"), but these marks sometimes vary to indicate special attributes for an entry, such as "|+", "|v" or "|xv."

3. The original ledger material has been slightly edited and obvious spelling and location errors corrected, but in all instances the original intent has been preserved. Otherwise the reader would be confronted with an endless number or annoying (sic) notations.
